Passive House Basics Course 2012

Hannover / Darmstadt, 02.05.2012 - Following on from the success of last year's first Passive House Basics course in the framework of the International Passive House Conference in Innsbruck, the same team of Passive House experts presented the Passive House Basics Course 2012 at the University of Applied Sciences and Arts in Hannover on 2 May, just two days before the start of the 16th International Passive House Conference.

Rainer Pfluger from the University of Innsbruck brought along a ventilation demonstration model to give a practical insight on the required components. The success story of innovative Passive House window frame development was visualised by Franz Freundorfer. Scientific researcher Witta Ebel from the Passive House Institute showed the Passive House quality offensive with a close look at economics from the first projects up to today.



Furthermore, the Basic course focused on regionally varying solutions to meet the Passive House Standard worldwide. Examples of certified Passive Houses in warm, hot & humid, but also cold climates explained the design principles. Course participants had the opportunity to ask questions to the experts and were certainly well-prepared for the conference to deepen their Passive House expertise.
